MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF LYNCHBURG, VIRGINIA

August 1, 2024

The meeting of the Board of Directors of the Economic Development Authority of the City of Lynchburg, Virginia, was held in the Conference Room of the Office of Economic Development & Tourism, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 900 Church Street, Lynchburg, Virginia, at 8:30 a.m. on Thursday, August 1, 2024, on call of the Chairman and upon written notice to all of the Directors. Ms. Upshur distributed copies of the Economic Development Authority of the City of Lynchburg, Virginia Handbook. Ms. Soerensen advised that her information needed updating.

Ms. Upshur briefly reported on the Lynchburg City Schools Education Foundation project sponsored by the Economic Development Authority.

Mr. Stone asked Ms. Upshur and Mr. Copper to provide the Staff Report. Ms. Upshur reported on the following:

- Ivy Creek Sites A+B were now approved and her office was proceeding with construction planning.
- She reported the GO Virginia grant is in closeout process.
- Ms. Upshur's staff reported that the Office of Economic Development and Tourism had achieved a number of definite leads and assists in June with an economic impact on the City of Lynchburg in the amount of \$2,599,750 and 9 tentative leads with an estimated economic impact of \$154,894.

Thereafter, on motion made by Mr. Tugman, seconded by Mr. Wood, the Board went into closed session pursuant to Section 2.2-3711(A)(3) of the Code of Virginia for discussion or consideration of the acquisition of real property for a public purpose, or of the disposition of publicly held real property, where discussion in an open meeting would adversely affect the bargaining position or negotiating strategy of the Authority.
